



WORKSHOP PHOTO HOLDER IN CLAY

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Useful and easy to make, the photo holder is a classic. Decorate it using POSCAs, make your own holder to show your photos to their advantage. With air-dry clay, it is child's play!

KIDS ACTIVITIES

WHAT YOU NEED:

- > Air-dry clay
- > A carving tool
(or an ordinary knife)
- > Wire
- > 1 wire cutter to cut and shape the wire
- > 1 pencil

POSCAS USED IN THIS WORKSHOP:

- > **TIP PC-3M**
emerald green, dark blue, lilac,
pink, light pink, light orange,
apple green, yellow, white
- > **BRUSH PCF-350**
silver.



01



Roll a piece of clay into a half-ball.

02



Roll two small balls for the eyes, and fix them on the half-ball using the carving tool.

03



Carve the mouth with the same tool.



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Artist tips:

Items such as feathers, shells or flowers in fabric can also be fixed on the character's head before the clay dries.

04



Cut 5 or 6 pieces of wire of equal size, then shape a spiral at the end of each wire using the wire cutter.

05



Fix the wires on top of the half-ball, let it dry and harden.

06



With a pencil make some drawings on the picture holder and colour them using POSCAs.
