WHAT YOU NEED:

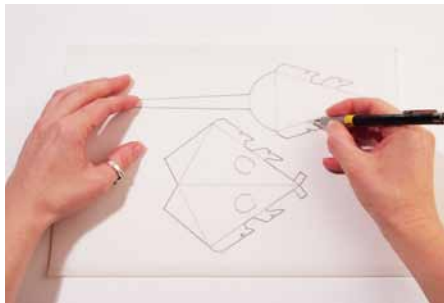
- > 1 sheet of drawing paper
- > 1 sheet of tracing paper
- > 1 template

- > 1 soft pencil (for tracing)
- > 1 pencil
- > 1 pair of scissors
- > 1 cutter

POSCAS USED IN THIS WORKSHOP:

- > TIP PC-3M
sky blue, yellow, apple green,
red, lilac, pink, light pink
- > TIP PC-1MR
black, white

Trace and transfer a mouse model to drawing paper (here we have used paper size A4), then cut it out

Fold the dotted lines shown on the model.

Customise and decorate both sides of the mouse.
